BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

Germain Seligman (1893-1978) was a French Captain assigned to the American Expeditionary Force in 1917. He served as Liason Officer to the First American Division until the end of the war. Following the war, he returned to the family art gallery Jacques Seligman et Fils given charge of the New York office. In 1923, he became president of the firm. He spent his life shuttling between Paris and New York retaining an active interest in art and national affairs of both nations.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND ARRANGEMENT:

There are several series within the papers. First there are Seligman's personal papers: correspondence, military records, copies of family photographs, and articles written by Seligman. Next there are military orders from World War II. Third there are military reports and instruction books. Last, is a folder of World War II era clippings from the U. S. press. Separated from the collection was a larger collection of World War I maps and five photographs.
