AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

GEORGE F. KREBS, 32482092, Sergeant, 925th Field Artillery Battalion, for meritorious service in direct support of combat operations during the period 1 November 1944 to 23 April 1945, in France and Germany. As chief of section of a firing battery, Sergeant Krebs capably and diligently supervised the performance of his section in the delivery of rapid artillery fire against the enemy. Despite frequent adverse weather, difficulties of terrain and subjection to counterbattery fire, by his efforts and leadership, Sergeant Krebs contributed greatly to the efficient performance of his battery. Entered military service from Trenton, New Jersey.
