BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL FEATURES:

As part of his doctoral studies, Larry I. Bland (1940-) undertook a study of W. Averell Harriman. The first part of this collection documents the research involved in this project and succeeding articles regarding Harriman. It includes articles by Bland, by Harriman and copied material from journals. Notes taken by Bland are also included.

From 1971-1976, Bland taught at Gaston College in Gastonia, North Carolina. While there he prepared readings and lectures for a proposed course on women's history. The second part of the collection concerns this. Included are popular articles and newspaper clippings about women as well as scholarly articles.
