BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL FEATURES: Milton Colvin is a distinguished professor in the field of American National Government. He received his PhD from the University of Heidelberg, Germany. Before joining the faculty of Washington and Lee University in 1961, Dr. Colvin taught at the University of Montana, Vanderbilt University, and the University of Chicago. He has held visiting professorships at the National War College, the University of Vienna, Austria, and Oxford University. In the spring of 1981, Dr. Colvin received a research fellowship from the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). He conducted his study in Germany on the topic of “The Pursuit of Détente in East-West Relations: The Impact of ‘Finlandisation’ on the Young in Germany.”
