BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

June 5, 1967, marked the twentieth anniversary of General Marshall's European Recovery Plan speech at Harvard. Ceremonies on both sides of the Atlantic commemorated the occasion during June 1967. Those which have come to the attention of the Marshall Research Library were: a colloquium in Brussels, June seventh and eighth; ceremonies in Bonn, June first and second, and in Vienna, June fifth; commemorative luncheons given in Paris by the OECD, June seventh; and a speech at Harvard by Prince Bernhard of the Netherlands, June tenth.

In June of 1977, ceremonies were held in Paris to mark the thirtieth anniversary of the Marshall Plan speech.
