BIOGRAPHICAL SUMMARY: General Andrew J. Goodpaster was born in 1915 in Granite City, Illinois. He attended the United States Military Academy at West Point graduating in 1939. He then served in the Panama Canal Zone and in North Africa and Italy during the Second World War. Goodpaster then served in the War Department and the Joint Chiefs of Staff. In the early 1950s, Goodpaster served at the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) and later as Commandant of the National War College. From 1969-1974, General Goodpaster served as Supreme Allied Commander in Europe before becoming Superintendent of the United States Military Academy at West Point, a post he held from 1977 until his retirement from the Army in 1981. Following his retirement from the army, Goodpaster served as Chairman of several organizations including the George C. Marshall Foundation.

SUBJECT: This collection consists of papers donated after General Goodpaster's death and primarily came from his home office. They contain correspondence, speeches, papers, and articles from the many projects and activities he participated in during his retirement. There is an extensive collection of periodical and newspaper articles covering many topics including the Vietnam era. The collection also includes a series of interviews with General Goodpaster conducted by Kenneth Mandel and James McCall between July 2001 and February 2004.
