#### Introduction

The Stuart B. Marshall collection was acquired by the George C. Marshall Research Foundation in 1967 from the estate of Stuart B. Marshall, Jr. The collection spans the years 1834 to 1959 and is arranged according to subject matter.

The first division includes genealogical records of several families and reflects Marshall's interest in his own family history. Also contained in this division is all correspondence dealing with a variety of topics.

The second major division contains a clippings file on various historical figures such as Washington, Jefferson, and Lee.

The third division contains a number of postcards, both American and foreign.

Also included in this collection are a number of family photographs, the majority portraying the Marshall family and the family of Florence Heaton, Stuart Marshall's wife.

Access to the collection is unrestricted.

# Scope and Content Note

The Stuart B. Marshall papers span the period 1834-1959 and include two linear feet of correspondence, photographs, postcards, clippings, publications by Stuart Marshall, clippings and articles on famous historical figures, and papers and records of the following families; Bradford, Catlett, Marshall, Stuart and Taliaferro.

Marshall's interest in the history of his own family as well as in various important historical figures is represented by the numerous genealogical records of several families and a large clipping file on historical figures such as Washington, Jefferson, and Lee.

Although the importance of the collection lies with the papers and records chronicling the history of the Marshall family, there is also early correspondence between Stuart Marshall and his brother George Catlett Marshall and a sizable collection of postcards, most of them from Stuart and George to their parents George Catlett Marshall, Sr. and Laura Bradford Marshall.

The collection also contains a number of family photographs, the majority being of the Marshall family and the family of Florence Heaton, Stuart Marshall's wife.

The Stuart B. Marshall collection is divided by subject matter into three distinct areas: genealogical records and correspondence, clippings, and postcards.
