BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

As historian, writer, forester, investor, Virginia Chairman to the United Nations Activities, Hampden-Sydney College's Patrick Henry Researcher, etc. Shelton H. Short's career is varied and extremely interesting. Worldwide travel augments his many American and foreign academic degrees. Currently he is a member of the Board of Trustees of the George C. Marshall Foundation.

This collection includes official and personal mementos of all the above and detailed resumes of the donor.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND ARRANGEMENT:

37 boxes. Boxes 1-5 are personal in nature with photographs and resume; travels and related materials consume boxes 5-15; 18-26 contain United Nations materials; miscellaneous and scrapbooks/photo albums comprise the remainder of the collection.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH Shelton H. Short, III, Ph., D.

Dr. Shelton H. Short, III, of Clarkesville and Chase City, Virginia, was born November 9, 1926 in Richmond, Virginia. The son of the late Honorable and Mrs. Shelton H. Short, Jr., Dr. Short attended Episcopal High School in Alexandria, received a B.A. from Hampden-Sydney College, an M.A. from the University of Nevada, and M.A. from the International College of Elsinore, and a Ph.D. from the University of Edinburgh. On November 25, 1991, Dr. Short married Jean Lewis Sherbondy of Mathias in Hardy County, West Virginia.

Dr. Short has served his state, nation, and community in many capacities. He was a volunteer in three branches of military service: at age 16, Virginia Protective Force/Virginia Home Militia; age 17, U.S. Army Air Corps; and age 20, the U.S. Marine Corps reserve. Also, Dr. Short has enjoyed many appointments that include Hampden-Sydney's Patrich Henry Researcher 1972-1973, John Randolph Bicentennial Historian 1975-1976 and Saint Paul's College's Researcher and Lecturer in West Indian Culture. In 1984, he was appointed Chairman to the United Nations Activities for the Commonwealth of Virginia. He served in this capacity for eight consecutive term (1984-1992). Dr. Short has travelled extensively through his work with the United Nations. He has served as a trustee for the George C. Marshall Foundation since 1989.

As a historian, writer, forester, and investor, Dr. Short is a member of several organizations that promote local, regional, and national history and preservation: Jamestown Society, Yorktown Patriots, Society of Cincinnati, A.P.V.A, Virginia Sons of the American Revolution, Francis Epes Society, Sons of Confederate Veterans, Huguenot Society, Virginia Historical Society, and the Order of the Stars and Bars.

A Certified Virginia Tree Farmer and active in forestry and land development matters, Dr. Short is active in numerous environmental organizations. Also, he is a trustee of the Forest Farmers Association Education and Research Foundation and a life member of the school of Forestry and Wildlife Resources Advisory Board at the Virginia Polytechnical Institute and State University.

Dr. Short was the first Eagle Scout in Mecklenburg County (1949) and served as Assistant Scout Master for Chase City's Troop 115. He is a life friend of the University of Edinburgh Library, the University of St. Andrew's Scotland Library, the Trinity College library of the University of Dublin, the National Library of Scotland, the National Library of Wales, the British Museum and the Royal Library of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert in London.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Shelton H. Short III Collection contains materials relevant to the life of Dr. Short between 1926-1992. The material is divided into eight series: personal items, correspondence, travel related materials, educational institutions, United Nations day activities, United Nations materials, miscellaneous items, and scrapbooks/photoalbums. The material is arranged alphabetically within each series.

The bulk of the collection, boxes 18-26, concern the United Nations materials. These items include U.N. reports, publications, and documents. Also, the items on the U.N. day activities, box 17, provide insight into the responsibilities of Dr. Short as the United Nations Activities Chairman for the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Much of the correspondence is personal in nature although there are some items of interest to researchers such as the exchange of correspondence between Charles Robb, Gerald Baliles, and Jay Rockefeller. The material in the series of personal items, boxes 1-2, ranges from photographs to an extensive resume of Dr. Short's life. The educational institutions that Dr. Short has been associated with over his career are represented in the series on education, box 16. His travels are represented in the series on travel related materials, boxes 5-15.

A series exist for miscellaneous items, boxes 27-29. Items represented in this category include World War II rations books and environmental conservation reports. Finally, Dr. Short's scrapbooks and photoalbums are located in boxes 30-38.
