Brigadier Gen. William A. Borden was born on March 20, 1890 in San Antonio, Texas. He graduated from Cornell University in 1912 with a degree in mechanical engineering and was married to Dorothy Adams in 1917. Since 1917 he has worked at various positions in the War Department,

The collection consists of memorabilia of William A. Borden, compiled in 1964, and edited by Hope Chamberlin. It contains genealogical information as well as notes on the military and post-military career of Borden.
