**Biographical/Historical Notes:** The 118<sup>th</sup> Signal Radio Intelligence Company was organized in 1942 at the United States Army Camp Perry, which was located between Cleveland and Toledo in Ohio. Under the direction of its first commanding officer, Lieutenant John Mitchell, the job of the 118<sup>th</sup> SRI Co. included providing administration of Company functions, administering the usual four weeks of basic training, and teaching the raw recruits the "Army Way" during the years 1942 through 1946.
