BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

Harold S. Frum edited letters he wrote during World War II into a narrative account of his tour of duty in Europe, Frum began his service in 1943 at Camp Reynolds, Pennsylvania. From there he went to Birmingham, England and Belfast, Northern Ireland, where he worked on classification and assignment of personnel. In mid-1944, Frum was transferred to France and by V-E Day he was in Germany.

Frum's account of these events is entitled "The Soldier Must Write."
