- Folder 1: Five photographs taken from an airplane
Fifteen photographs of destroyed buildings, trains, and bridges, Rome, military personnel, airfields, etc.
- Folder 2: Thirty-eight photographs (half are duplicates) of the hanging of Mussolini and others after their capture by Italian patriots.
- Folder 3: Sixty-two photographs (half are duplicates) of Europe during World War II: Vesuvius erupting, destroyed buildings, landscapes, bridges, trains, etc., airplanes dropping bombs, D-Day, others.
- Folder 4: Twenty-five photographs, mostly of airplanes in flight.
- Folder 5: One hundred-fifty photocopies of these photographs.
