Theodore Stanwood Kenyon (-1978) a New York Lawyer, served as commander of Company B, 306th Infantry, 77th Division of the AEF. Wounded in action while in France, Kenyon received the Distinguished Service Cross and the French Legion of Honor.

The 23 letters are to Marian Holden, a family friend of Kenyon's. They describe life in Camp Upton, New York, his tour in France and happenings back home.
