John F. Lawrence enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1943 and served in the Pacific Theater during World War II. He was stationed in Hawaii from 1944-1945. In 1944 Lawrence was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, and the Marksman Medal.
