BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

Henry D. MacNaughton of Michigan was a major in the Army during World War I, and served in France. The collection is made up of a diary, complete with sketches and drawings, notes on aircraft, officers billets, which MacNaughton kept during 1918. A dinner menu is included, plus a passenger list, dated March 16, 1919, for the USS Pocahontas, which left from St. Nazaire, France. MacNaughton's name appears on this list. A book, The History of the 32nd Infantry Division in World War II, is also part of the collection.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND ARRANGEMENT:

The diary and papers are located in a single folder. An incomplete index is located in the donor folder. The book has been transferred to the library.
