BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL FEATURES: Frank McCarthy was born in Richmond, Virginia on June 8, 1912. He graduated from VMI in 1933 and worked in various journalistic positions until 1940 when he joined the War Department General Staff. There he served as Assistant Secretary and later Secretary of the General Staff, and also secretary to the Chief of Staff, General George C. Marshall. In 1945, McCarthy left the War Department and accepted a position in Hollywood with the Motion Picture Association of America.

Aside from his professional correspondence, McCarthy maintained a steady connection to the Marshalls. He wrote and visited frequently. Immensely proud of his mentor, McCarthy kept newspaper articles, mementos from time in Marshall's service, and personal letters from General and Mrs. Marshall. In his love for "Dear Frank," George Marshall writes with warmth and feeling uncharacteristic of the reputedly detached general. The collection also contains speeches about General Marshall written by McCarthy, as well as correspondence and a transcript of a seminar concerning the award-winning movie "Patton."
