BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

In 1938 the VMI corps voted to change the corps trip from one to Richmond to one to Charlotte, North Carolina to attend the VMI-Clemson football game. In 1940 the corps again went south, this time to see VMI play Davidson. A highlight of this second trip was the appearance of George C. Marshall at the game. This scrapbook records all of the events involved in both corps trips with clippings from the Charlotte newspapers and the VMI Cadet. Charles B. Miller, president of the Charlotte chapter of the VMI alumni, was instrumental in getting the corps trip changed and in making arrangements for George C. Marshall to attend.
