## BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

Ann Archer Hogshead Tullidge (1902-1995) of Staunton, Virginia, compiled the pamphlet, "A Paratroopers Faith", for her son, George, a sergeant in the 507th Parachute Infantry Regiment of the 82nd Airborne Division. After his death on July 8, 1944 in the Normandy invasion, she published the booklet.

On July 24, 1989, Ann Tullidge was awarded the "Decoration for Distinguished Civilian Service" by the Secretary of the Army for publishing and distributing, at her own expense, over 300,000 copies of the booklet to World War II soldiers. She also received an Iron Mike award from the 82nd Airborne Division
