ANDREW J. GOODPASTER AWARD TO GENERAL RAYMOND T. ODIERNO

General Raymond T. Odierno, USA, will receive the 2014 Andrew J. Goodpaster Award in recognition of his distinguished career in the U.S. Army and his leadership as the 38th Chief of Staff. General Odierno assumed duty as Chief of Staff in September 2011. A native of Rockaway, NJ, he graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1976 with a commission in field artillery. During more than 37 years of service, he has commanded units at every echelon, from platoon to theater, with duty in Germany, Albania, Kuwait, Iraq, and the United States.

The Andrew J. Goodpaster Award of the George C. Marshall Foundation honors the service of General Andrew J. Goodpaster, a longtime trustee and chairman of the Marshall Foundation, a champion of the Marshall legacy, an American hero and an extraordinary public servant. The Goodpaster Award is presented to Americans in a variety of fields who have exhibited great courage, selfless service, patriotism and leadership in their lives and careers.

The independent, non-profit George C. Marshall Foundation, located in Lexington, Virginia, celebrates the legacy of George C. Marshall, Army chief of staff during WWII, secretary of state and secretary of defense. With its museum, research library, and archives, the Foundation is the place where the values that shaped and motivated Marshall are kept alive. The Foundation perpetuates Marshall's exemplary character and extraordinary accomplishments through its leadership, scholarship and statesmanship programs.
