BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

William Douglas Pawley (1896-1977) had a long active business and diplomatic career. At eighteen, he began working in Latin America for a New York import firm travelling to all nations there. In the 1930's Pawley, as head of the Inter-continental Corporation, became president of China's first national airline. Out of this came Pawley's organization of the Flying Tigers, an American Volunteer Aviation group for the defense of China. Following World War II, Pawley served as Ambassador to both Peru and Brazil and as a special assistant to both the Secretary of State and Defense.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND ARRANGEMENT:

The collection consists of correspondence, both personal and official between Pawley and George C. Marshall, personal letters from Katherine T. Marshall and other official correspondence of Pawley's. Also included are a draft of Pawley's unpublished draft Russia Is Winning and an article on Vietnam, a history of the Flying Tigers and Pawley's 1960 testimony on communism in the Caribbean.

Photographs from the Bogota Conference (1948) have been housed separately.
