BIOGRAPHICAL AND SUBJECT SUMMARY:

Born on 6 August 1940 in Englewood, New Jersey, Jay R. Sculley attended and received a B.S. from Virginia Military Institute in 1962. In 1974 he received his Ph.D. in Environmental Engineering from Johns Hopkins University. During the late 1970's Dr. Sculley taught Civil Engineering at V.M.I. In October 1981, he became the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Research, Development and Acquisition). He held the job until 1989. Currently, Dr. Sculley is Chairman and CEO of Allied Research Corporation.

The collection includes all documents relating to Dr. Sculley's position as Assistant Secretary of the Army (Research, Development and Acquisition).

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION AND ARRANGEMENT:

64 Boxes. Boxes 1-35 are official correspondence; travel related materials consume boxes 36-50; 51-55 contain daily planner calendars; speeches make up boxes 56-60; personal correspondence, trip reports, and miscellaneous comprise the remainder of the collection.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Jay R. Sculley Collection contains materials relevant to the work of Dr. Sculley from 1981-1989 when he served as Assistant Secretary of the Army for Research, Development and Acquisition (ASA, RDA). The material is divided into seven series: Official Correspondence, Travel, Calendar, Speeches, Personal Correspondence, Trip Reports, and Miscellaneous. The material is arranged chronologically within each series.

The bulk of the collection, boxes 1-35, contain official correspondence related to Dr. Sculley's position as ASA, RDA. This includes letters, memorandums, and reports between Dr. Sculley and other members of the Pentagon, members of Congress, and representatives from businesses who had or were seeking defense contracts. These items would be of particular interest to researchers because they help to illustrate the rapid expansion of the military which took place during the Reagan administration. Also in this series is a scattering of letters of a personal nature, generally consisting of congratulatory messages or invitations to meals. It should be noted that within box 1 are the official correspondence of Percy A. Pierre, the outgoing ASA, RDA from the Carter administration and Arthur Daoulas, the acting ASA, RDA from February 1981until October 1981 when Dr. Sculley took over the position.

Items in the Travel series, boxes 36-50, consist of itineraries, memorandums, and letters relating to official trips taken by Dr. Sculley. An occasional photograph from some of the trips have been included and are duly noted. The Calendar series, boxes 51-55, contains the daily planners used by Dr. Sculley for his time as ASA, RDA, while copies of the numerous speeches he made during this same time period are found in the Speeches series, boxes 56-60.

Box 61 contains his personal correspondence, including letters between Dr. Sculley and his family, friends, and former students from the Virginia Military Institute. The series runs from May 1981 to February 1982. Memorandums concerning official trips from Dr. Sculley's colleagues in the Pentagon are found in the Trip Reports Series, box 62. This series runs from June 1984 to May 1985. The final series of the collection, Miscellaneous, found in boxes 63-64, includes: phone logs; letters of recommendations, and press articles.
